Day 1/3: Friday from 10h00

Short weekend break – Arrive own time the Friday and enjoy a T-Bone braai with all the guests. All included are Salads, Pap & Sause, Meat and braai fire. We enjoy a late evening and take up our sweet dreams after 23h00



Day 3/3: Sunday from 06h00-13h00

Second late morning and coffee and rusks from 06h00 in the open. At will the 2nd Game drive through Pilansberg by 07h00. Early lunch at 12h00 with curry Sheep neck, rice and sweet potatoes with salads and a nice glass of wine. After lunch the guests are welcome to stay, sleep a bit and leave with own timings via the Park to Manyane Gate & out.



Day 2/3: Saturday from 06h00-23h00

Late morning if the lions leave as to sleep late. Coffee and rusks from 06h00. Brunch at 10h00 and after brunch a short story and discussion on lions. Then, at own will you can visit Pilansberg NP and spend the day in the field, looking for the Big 5. Supper at 19h30 on the grass and we spend the evening around a Bushveld fire



Facilities

Bakgatla also has a shop that you can buy essentials such as, braai coal, bottled water, bread, milk and more. The restaurant there has an excellent menu to suite your tastes. It is a wonderful way to get to spend some time in peaceful surroundings and easy access to Sun City, entertainment city with Valley of the Waves

Chalets and Rooms

4 Bed chalets - 1 Bedroom with a double bed and two single beds in the loft, kitchen, bathroom with shower cubicle. Open plan kitchen, air-conditioning and a private patio.
Studio rooms consist of 1 bedroom with 2 single beds, bar fridge and shower .
No self catering available at rooms

Caravan Park and Camping

Bakgatla resort is a must camping site. There are 100 spots to pitch a tent, broken into 40 spots that are electrified and 60 spots not electrified.
Caravan Park: All sites are grassed and electrified and can accommodate a maximum of 6 people and 2 motor vehicles per site. Sites have centrally situated ablution facilities. Access to the restaurant, pool, playgrounds and on-site shop.
Camping: Requests for electrified sites are essential. Max of 6 people and 2 motor vehicles per site.

Own Game drive in Pilansberg

The great thing about Bakgatla is that you can within minutes be in the Pilansberg National Park, viewing magnificent wildlife. It is still amazing to understand that the animals in the park, including the big five were relocated there in one of the largest translocations ever undertaken. The hides over looking the dams and waterholes are brilliant of enjoying the birds, animals and landscapes.
