Day 1-3/19: Drive to Ruacana

Via Kang, Tsumeb & Oshikati

Day 4/19: Group at Ruacana

Camp at Eha Lodge where all guests meet, for final briefing by Alex on the route for the next day!

Day 5/19: Drive to Swartbooisdrif

Cunene water level determined the way to Swartbooisdrif and Epupa falls where we stop at the graves of some Dorsland Trekkers

Day 6-7/19: Epupa falls - Cunene

Via the easier road we drive to the community camp and stay for 2 days. Hiking and swimming is likely



Day 8/19: Drive to Van Zyl's Camp site before Van Zyl's pass

By experience this is the most difficult road and day of the 19 days on this safari. The road initial is fine till about 12h00 then we proceed on very serious off-road track between Okongwati via Etengwa to Otjitanda. Road building is possible and arrival is after sunset at our Community Campsite.



Day 9/19: Van Zyl's Pass

The pass have 3 stretches. The 1st very rocky / rough – 8km The 2nd view over the Mariaan Fluss The 3rd very steep down hill for about 2 hours and only 4 kilometres in length. Heavy stuff! For today



Day 10/19: Second day at Camp Syncro

After Van Zyl's pass we rest on the banks of the Cunene river & explore!

Day 11-12/19: Hartmanns Mountains

We follow the Marian fluss and drive south to Red dum, followed by Blue, Orange and Green drums where we camp in the field between the mountains from where we can see the huge sand dunes of the Skeleton Coast



Day 13/19: Hartmann's valley

Drive South east to Puros via Orupembe and camp at Puros Community Camp

Day 14-15/19: Photographic hunt for the Desert Elephants

Early morning the dominate bull comes and visit our shower for water, even before we had some coffee to drink! After breakfast we drive up and down the Hoarusib River to find this animals. We explore the scenery and drink a sun downer on the hill close by

Day 16/19: Leave Kaokoland

We re-fuel at Sesfontein and leave Kaokoland at Palmwag where we clear the veterinarian gate. From here you may drive on your own if you have booked this option



Day 17-19/19: Team effort to return to South Africa

We return via Swakopmund, Windhoek, Gobabis and Lobatse

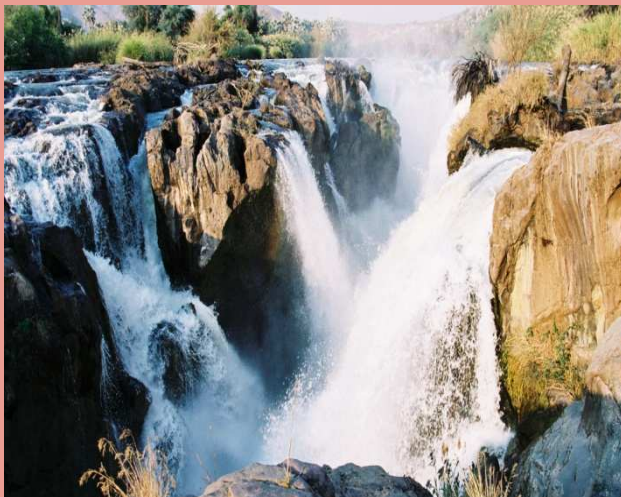
